- Please present to gear check 20 mins prior to your riding time. Riders may be requested to ride earlier than their allocated time.
- The Ground Jury will consist of the 3 senior judges on the day.
- The Appeals Committee will consist of the senior judge, the YVDC president and the YVDC secretary.
