<u>Club Day Entries -</u> Please note that <u>NO LATE ENTRIES</u> will be accepted after the closing date in the future for our club comps. If you have special requests for times or duties, please put them with the entries at the time so as our event secretary can try to accommodate them if possible and organize the day and draw without having to reschedule everyone several times.

Another forward thinking idea we are going to implement at all of or club days (excluding official comps) is allowing the use of a snaffle bit at ALL LEVELS including the FEI Tests. Riders will now have the choice to use either a double bridle or a snaffle in Advanced and above tests. This change takes place immediately.


