Bridget's Story

Hello Yarra Valley Dressage Clubbers,

I'd like to start by thanking everyone who was at the AMG for their kind words and encouragement after my talk. As a naturally shy person, public speaking isn't an easy thing to do, but you made me feel very welcome, so thank you! It was suggested on the night, that I should write up a little something for the newsletter, so those that couldn't make it could learn about who I am, and what I'm trying to do, so here it is!

I was born with a physical disability that has resulted in short stature, severe spinal scoliosis and restricted movement in my joints, and it was eventually labelled as 'Multiple Pterygium Syndrome'. I was also born with the deep passion and obsession for horses. I would beg and plead for my own horse, and to ride any horse I saw from day one. However, for the first 10 years of my life I was in and out of hospital having different operations, trying to increase my range of movement, and to stabilise my spine. Eventually, after years of my nagging, the Doctors said ok to me riding, and from then on there was no stopping me. I was lucky enough to have some wonderful ponies leased to me, until I 'finally' got my very own pony.

I soon joined up to my local pony club and spent many years there being an active member of the club. In my senior years at pony club I began instructing, going on to become certified, and have since returned to the pony club scene as a coach and judge.

After pony club I joined HRCav, by then I had a Welsh pony (Ted), and my focus had switched primarily to dressage. Unfortunately, early 2017, Ted had to be spelled due to soundness issues, which at the time was heart breaking, but actually turned out to be the catalyst to how I ended up where I am today!

At the same time Ted was spelled, Paralympian Sharon Jarvis, had moved to Victoria and had heard about me via mutual friends, so she contacted me and insisted I go meet her. Being horseless must have weakened my senses, as I said yes, and before I knew it she had me signed up to get classified in October 2017 at the Para Dressage National Championships.

Para Dressage is separated into 5 grades, with grade 1 being for the most impaired, and grade 5 for the least impaired. I was classified as a grade 2 rider, which means I walk and trot with lateral work in my tests. The 'Para' in Para Dressage, or Paralympics actually stands for Parallel, which means we are to be judged as if we are riding alongside able bodied riders doing the same movements.

After being classified, the hunt for a para dressage horse began, and in March 2018 I was introduced to Allysee Smith's super pony, Kooralyn Sunrise. It sounds cliché, but everything just clicked. With just 7 rides together we headed to our first competition, (here at YVDC!!), and from then it just took off! In June we went to Boneo Winter CDI, and were identified as High Performance candidates and encouraged to join the campaign for the 2020 Tokyo Paralympics! And that was the start of an amazing whirlwind of a year.

October 2018, one year since I was classified, we headed to the Para Nationals at Boneo, my first time riding with, and meeting other para riders and it was amazing. Coming home as Australian Champion was just the icing on the cake. November saw us at Equitana as part of the Equestrian Australia Para Equestrian Squad, and part of the Schockemohle Masterclass with Brett Parbery, Chris Burton and Shane Davidson. December was the

Victorian Dressage Championships where we came reserve champions. January 2019 was the first Tokyo Qualifier event at the Boneo Classic.

In April we attended the second qualifier in Sydney (my first interstate comp), coming home reserve champs. And in July I was a finalist for Para Equestrian of the Year for the EV Awards. I've also made the Victorian Dressage Squad and the National High Performance Squad.

This crazy dream we had has taken off with a life of its own. We are working hard and giving it everything we've got! There are 5 selection events left to go, 3 here in Victoria, and 2 in NSW. With the huge cost involved with attending these competitions, I wanted to thank YVDC for being so welcoming and accommodating to me. Being able to run through tests, get feedback, and try out new approaches in such a supportive environment is an absolutely wonderful thing to be able to access. I sincerely appreciate it!

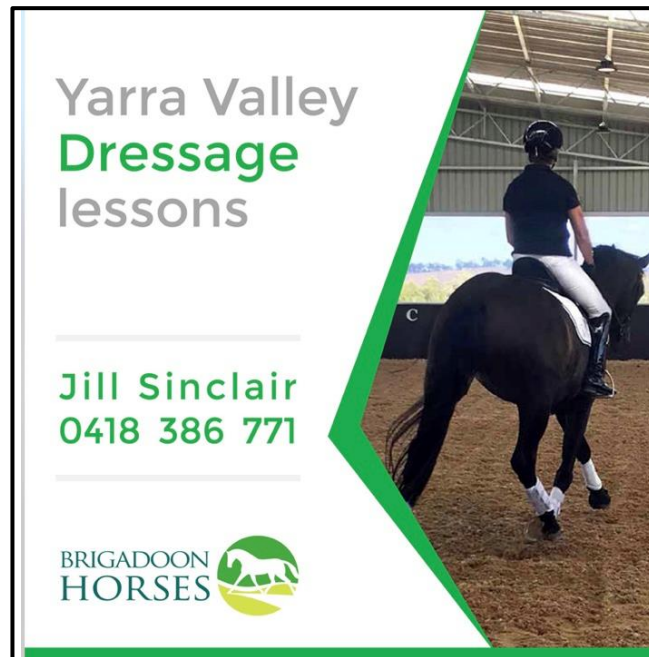

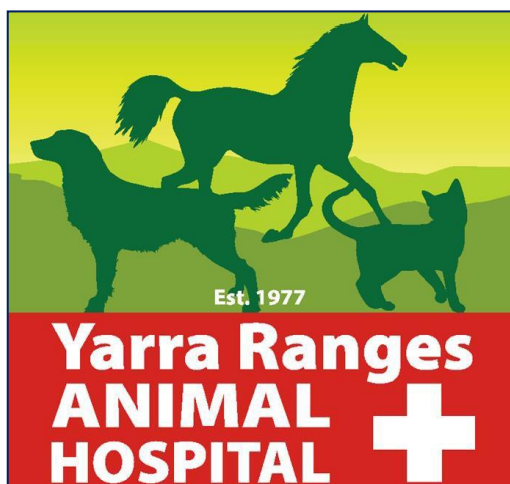

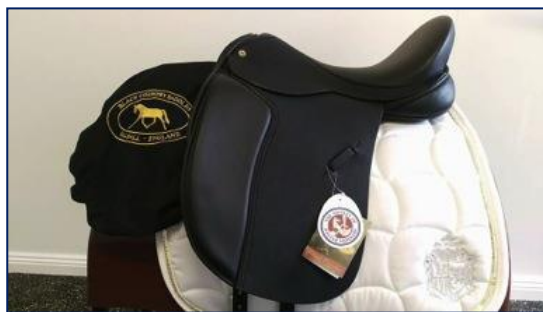
